What is your role at Our Savior?

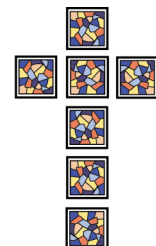
I am the Kindergarten Aide. This is my third year in the classroom with Miss Allen. I was a substitute teacher for many years at Our Savior before I took the aide position.
