**What is your favorite subject to teach? Why?**

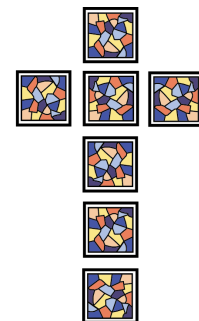
*One subject I like to teach is science because of all the hands on activities that help students to learn about the world with which God has blessed us.*
