*I started working at Our Savior when my family moved to Lansing 3 years ago. I really*

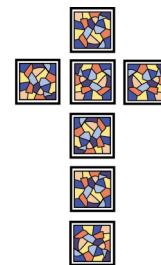
*enjoy working with children so I was excited for the opportunity to work in a classroom. This is my second year being an aide.*
