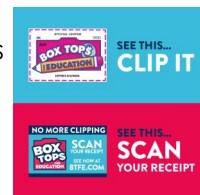
### AMAZON BOOK WISH LIST

### BOX TOPS FOR EDUCATION GOES DIGITAL

Did you know you can download the Box Tops app to start earning box tops for OSL? It's easy to use and anyone can use it. Encourage your family, friends and neighbors to download it as well, they can earn money for our school too (just have them choose Our Savior as their benefiting school). You simply take a photo of your receipt in the app and the box top money automatically posts to the OSL account. If you have products that still have the clippable box tops, please still send them with your child to school. We will be submitting them in November, so do a quick check in your cupboards and pantry to see if you have any that need to be clipped. If you don't want to download the app, but have purchased items with box tops, you can bring your receipt to the school office and a PTL volunteer will scan them in.
