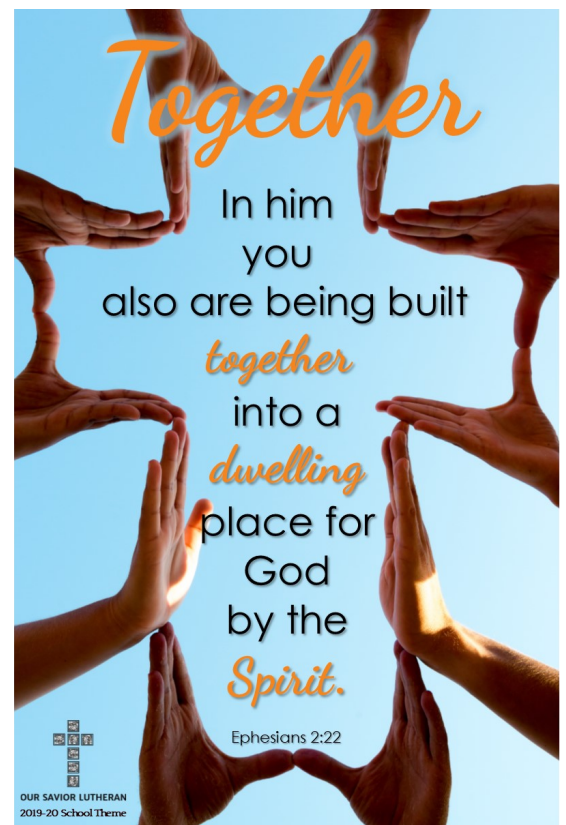

Pick Up/Drop off Belongings June 3 & 4
