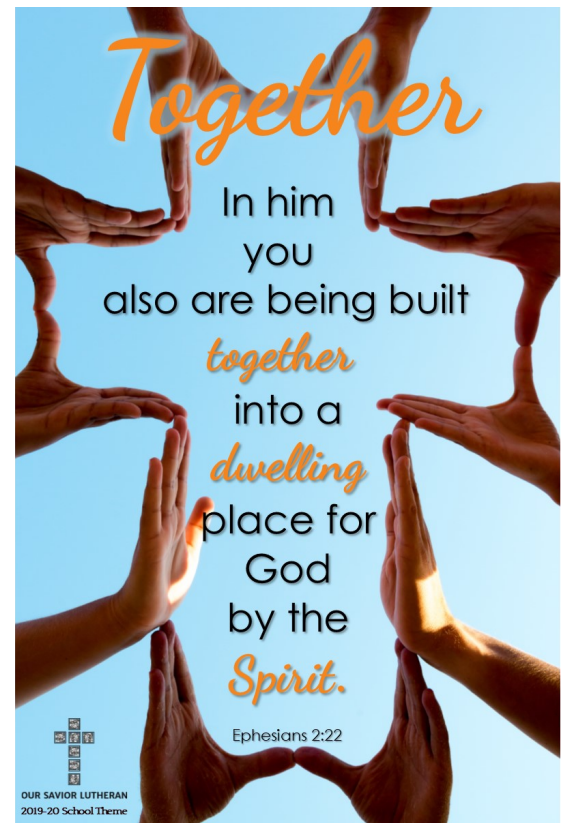

## Pick Up/Drop off Belongings June 3 & 4

Wednesday and Thursday, June 3rd and 4th will be designated pick up/drop off days for families at Our Savior. Times available for you to drop off items belonging to the school and pick up your child's items will be from 10-12 and 4-6 each day. If for some reason you are unable to make it during those times, please email Deb at [dwalworth@oursaviorlansing.org](mailto:dwalworth@oursaviorlansing.org) to make other arrangements. Parents will enter and drive through the parking lot just as they would for carline. (see attached map) There will be a drop off station at the school entrance for items belonging to the school. Parents will then drive up to the church entrance to receive the items belonging to their child(ren). Parents will be asked to remain in their vehicles and staff will take care of the items being dropped off and picked up. If you still have your carline tag with your name on it, please make that visible when you drive up, to help the staff get your items in a timely manner. Your child's yearbook, awards and recognitions will also be in with the items being picked up. Please be sure to look for envelopes containing medals or folders containing their certificates. Teachers have been busy putting together student's belongings from their lockers, desks and classrooms. All items have been put in a bag with the student's name on it.

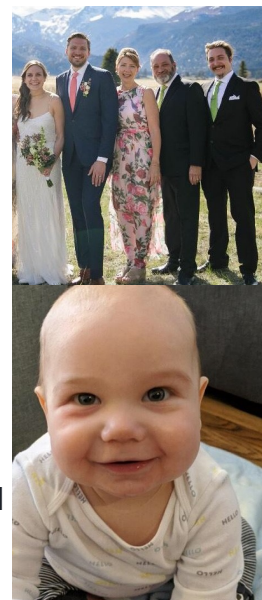
