Where do you see yourself in 10 years?

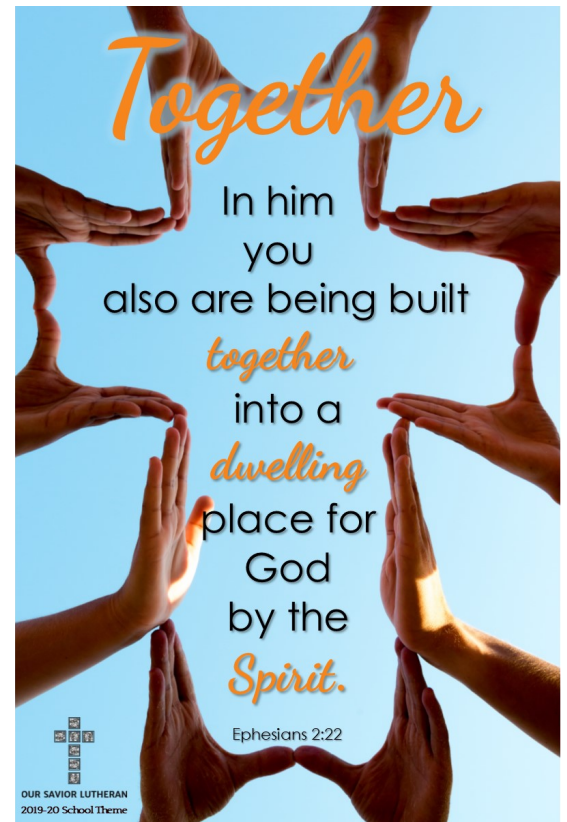
Out of college and working in my chosen field (I don't know what that is yet)

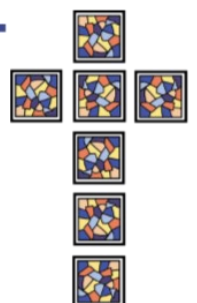
