School Picture Day

School Picture Day will be Wednesday, September 16th. Pre-K(4 year old) through Grade 8 students will have their pictures taken with their classes during the school day. We are currently working out a schedule with the photographer for distance learners to come in at a special time to get their pictures taken. More information on this will be coming. Picture packets for ordering will be sent home the end of this week. They are to be returned to your child's teacher the day of pictures.



Attendance

If your child is ill and will be out of school for the day, please notify the school by calling the attendance line at 517-925-5059 or email attendance@oursaviorlansing.org. Please state your child's name, grade, date of absence and the specific reason for the absence. Please note this year due to COVID-19 we need to know specifics as to why your child is not in school. If you leave the message that your child is sick, the school will call you to see exactly what symptoms your child has. Thank you for your help in keeping our students, teachers and staff safe.



Medications at School

If your child must take medication during the school day, please bring that medicine to the school office and complete a Medication Permission form. Children who keep inhalers in their backpacks should also have a Medication Permission form on file in the school office. All medicine must be in the original packaging and labeled with your child's name. If you think your child may need medicine for headaches or sore throats, please supply the office with the appropriate medication you wish your child to have. The school office does not keep any medication on hand to give your child. If your child has a headache or needs medication during the day and we do not have that medication from the parent, a call will be made to the parent to bring medication.

Required Documents

Child Information Records, Health Appraisals & Immunization Records or Waivers(EC, K, new students & 7th grade) should be turned into the school office as soon as possible. These documents are necessary for licensing, reporting requirements and the safety of your children while at school. You may drop them off in the receptionist office or email them to dwalworth@oursaviorlansing.org.
