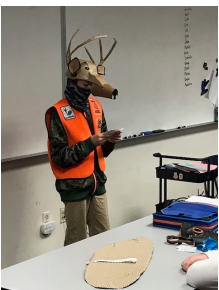

Attendance

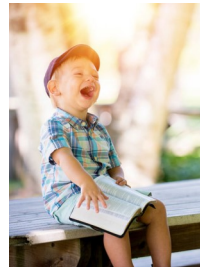
