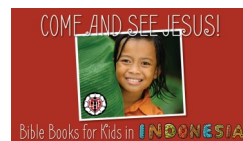
School Closing for Inclement Weather

Books for Indonesia

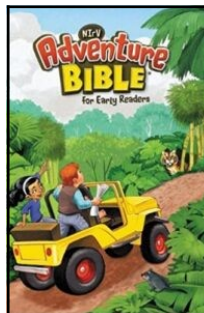
Second trimester offerings will be going to Bible Story books for children in Indonesia.
