Share the Light and Earn Tuition Credit for 2021-22 School Year

We invite school families to assist us with the growth of our school through our referral program, Share the Light. A tuition credit of \$200 per new student is available to current school families who refer new school families. All you have to do is refer a new school family and be sure to tell the family you are referring to put your name on their enrollment form. If that new family is still enrolled at the beginning of

October, you get your tuition credit applied directly to your TADS account. If you'd like a school brochure to share with someone, please feel free to stop in the school office and pick one up.
