NWEA Testing October 4th-8th

Each K8 student will be taking NWEA Map Growth tests next week. Teachers will be proctoring the online test. K8 students use iPads and Chromebooks and have as much time as they need to complete the Math and Reading Map Growth tests (and Language Arts for grades 3-8). The test includes multiple choice, drag-and-drop, and other types of questions. Map Growth results are one of many data points that teachers use to determine how a student is performing. We continue to measure student growth with a winter (February) and Spring (May) test. Each homeroom teacher has a daily schedule for their classes tests. Looking forward to seeing students give their best effort.
