



EARLY CHILDHOOD PROGRAMS SUPPLY LIST

All Ages/Programs - REQUIRED

- 2 boxes Crayola markers
- 2 sets Crayola watercolor paints
- 1 box facial tissue
- 2 packages Expo dry erase markers
- Full-body Rain/Mud Suit (one or two pieces) – please see examples/recommendations below:

****Please order TWO sizes up to fit over snow pants in winter****

-**Oaki** – very sturdy material, zippers seem to last longer than other brands, best overall value. \$40-\$60

-**Hapiu** – very sturdy material, good for children who love to actively play in water and mud. Runs small, zippers tend to break with lots of active mud play, only available up to 5T, \$27-\$40

-**Splashy** – very sturdy, good for children who love to actively play in water and mud. Runs true to size, available up to size 8. \$25-\$33

-**Tuffo** – good waterproofing, great for light use, zippers tend to break with lots of muddy play, available up to 5T. \$27-\$37

-**Dry Kids** – good waterproofing, great for light use, material tends to tear with lots of active wet play, available up to 11-12 \$25

-**Rusty Keeler** – good waterproofing, two-piece, forgiving in size as children grow, NO ZIPPER, \$32.50 + shipping, only available on rustykeeler.com

-**CeLaVi** – two-piece, overalls with zipper coat

- **Bag w/Extra Changes of Clothing** – this bag will stay in child's cubby at school until needed; wet/soiled clothing will be sent home and new extra clothing will need to be replaced throughout year
- **Weather-Appropriate Outdoor Clothing** – fall jacket, winter coat, snow boots, rain boots, snow pants, mittens/gloves, hat; children will go outside daily and experience all weather

Full Day Children - REQUIRED

- **Rest Time Supplies** –blanket to cover child, small pillow and/or comfort item if desired; rest time items will stay in the classroom throughout the week and will be returned to parents for laundering at the end of each week

All Children – OPTIONAL

- **Indoor Shoes** – All students and staff will not wear outdoor shoes in the classrooms. If children wish, they can wear non-slip slippers or slip-on shoes in the classroom, to be kept at school.
