### **Food Bank Needs**

The food bank is in need of new or gently used children's and school aged kids winter clothing and gear. They are also in need of plastic grocery bags. These donations and any non-perishable food can be dropped off to the food bank bin in the church lobby.

### **Medications at School**

If your child must take medication during the school day, please bring that medicine to the school office and complete a Medication Permission form. Children who keep inhalers in their backpacks should also have a Medication Permission form on file in the school office. All medicine must be in the original packaging and labeled with your child's name. If you think your child may need medicine for headaches or sore throats, please supply the office with the appropriate medication you wish your child to have. The school office does not keep any medication on hand to give your child. If your child has a headache or needs medication and we do not have that medication from the parent, a call will be made to the parent to bring medication.
