Attendance & Early Pickup

If your child is ill and will be out of school for the day or will need to be picked up early, please notify the school by calling 517-882-8665 or email attendance@oursaviorlansing.org. Please state your child's name, grade, date of absence and the specific reason for the absence. If your student is leaving early, please also notify their teacher.

Medications at School

If your child must take medication during the school day, please bring that medicine to the school office and complete a Medication Permission form. Children who keep inhalers in their backpacks should also have a Medication Permission form on file in the school office. All medicine must be in the original packaging and labeled with your child's name. If you think your child may need medicine for headaches or sore throats, please supply the office with the appropriate medication you wish your child to have. The school office does not keep any medication on hand to give your child. If your child has a headache or needs medication and we do not have that medication from the parent, a call will be made to the parent to bring medication.
