Attendance and Early Pickup From School

If your child is ill and will be out of school for the day, or if you need to pick your child up from school early, please be sure to notify both the office and your child's teacher by calling 517-882-8665 or email

attendance@oursaviorlansing.org. Please state your child's name, grade, date of absence and the specific reason for the absence or what time they will be leaving. Please go to the school office to sign out your child for any early pick ups.

Medications at School

If your child must take medication during the school day, please bring that medicine to the school office and complete a Medication Permission form. Children who keep inhalers in their backpacks should also have a Medication Permission form on file in the school office. All medicine must be in the original packaging and labeled with your child's name. If you think your child may need medicine for headaches or sore throats, please supply the office with the appropriate medication you wish your child to have. The school office does not keep any medication on hand to give your child. If your child has a headache or needs medication and we do not have that medication from the parent, a call will be made to the parent to bring medication.
